Butterfly Happy Birthday Card

Difficulty: A Step Up (Medium)



Supplies:

Stamps

Directions:

1. Score 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Dapper Demin Cardstock at 4 1/4", fold in half to make card base.
2. Attach 4" x 5 1/4" Basic Black Cardstock on the front of card using SNAIL Adhesive.
3. Stamp butterfly on 3 3/4" x 5" Watercolor Paper with VersaMark® pad. Sprinkle some embossing powder over your stamped image while it is still wet. Tap off the excess powder onto a scrap paper to pour back into the container. Use your heat tool to melt the powder until it becomes shiny.
4. Lay the embossed Watercolor Paper on a paper towel. Brush water on with Aqua Painter leaving the top 2" dry. Sprinkle Prussian Blue and a little Yellow Brusho Crystal Colours on the wet area. Spay additional water over the wet area with a Stampin' Spritzer to move colors around. Let Watercolor Paper dry completely.

Tip – DO NOT open Brusho Crystal Colour containers. Pierce one time with thumb tac and store with thumb tac in top.

5. Stamp wording with Basic Black pad at the top of dry Watercolor Paper.
6. Tie 13" Daffodil Delight 1/4" Double-Stitched Ribbon around Watercolor Paper.
7. Attach Watercolor Paper to card base with SNAIL Adhesive.
